Section I: Information

About the scholarship

The AIEF-BHP Billiton Tertiary Scholarship is awarded to outstanding Indigenous students undertaking engineering and other mining-related degrees, who aspire to work with BHP Billiton and to one day become leaders in the business.

The scholarship covers the cost of tertiary residential college accommodation and some other educational expenses, and offers ongoing professional development and career support from AIEF and BHP Billiton.

Applications for the AIEF-BHP Billiton Tertiary Scholarship must be submitted before Sunday, 1 February 2015.





Am I eligible?

To be eligible for an AIEF-BHP Billiton Tertiary Scholarship you must:

- Be an Australian resident;
- Be of Australian Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent and able to provide supporting evidence of this;
- Be enrolled full-time to study an eligible degree at an Australian university or applying to enrol full-time at an Australian university, having selected an eligible degree as a first preference;
- Demonstrate strong academic achievement and potential;
- Not be in receipt of any other scholarship, cadetship or similar support;
- Be enthusiastic about a career in the mining industry, and more specifically with BHP Billiton; and
- Be willing to apply for and participate in the BHP Billiton Iron Ore Undergraduate Program and the BHP Billiton Graduate Program in Perth or the Pilbara, Western Australia.

Please note that preference will be given to applicants that are currently residing in or are planning to reside in a university residential college.

Students part way through their undergraduate degree are encouraged to apply.

- 16. Science Spatial (Surveying)
- 17. Other mining-related degrees as approved by AIEF.





What does the scholarship cover?

- The cost of residential accommodation, compulsory fees, meals and other expenses at a tertiary residential college of your choice, up to a maximum of \$22,000 per annum, paid directly to the college (if applicable);
- An annual stipend of up to \$2,000 per annum for text books and other materials, or other education-related expenses; and
- A living allowance of up to \$6,000 per annum.

AIEF-BHP Billiton Tertiary Scholarship Students also receive ongoing professional development and career support from AIEF and BHP Billiton, including the opportunity to attend events and apply for the BHP Billiton Summer Undergraduate Program (vacation internship), see page 5 for more information.

Students also have the opportunity to apply for the BHP Billiton Graduate Program following the successful completion of their degree.

How do I apply?

You must submit a completed AIEF-BHP Billiton Tertiary Scholarship Application Form (2015) before Sunday, 1 February 2015 to be considered for the AIEF-BHP Billiton Tertiary Scholarship.

Applications will be assessed by a selection panel, with an emphasis on:

- Academic ability, achievement and potential (including the ability to maintain a credit average grade);
- Interest in and commitment to working in the mining industry; and
- Interest in and commitment to working with BHP Billiton on completion of your degree.

You may be asked to attend an interview as part of the application process. Interviews will be conducted either by telephone or in person at AIEF's office in Sydney.



Tim has embraced the unique career development opportunities on offer as a result of his scholarship, completing the BHP Billiton Summer Undergraduate Program over the 2013/14 summer holidays in Newman, WA.

He says the experience was interesting and rewarding: "We got to work with heaps of different teams and learn how they work together to achieve targets for the mine as a whole. It was really cool getting to know the different areas and roles and getting a chance to actually contribute and do some meaningful work."

After completing the Program Tim was successful in obtaining a Graduate Mining Engineer role in the 2015 BHP Billiton Graduate Program.
